  - Lock your vehicles, close your garage doors!
  - Beware of Porch Pirates – deliver to a back door or require signature
  - Vaccine scams – there is no fee to register for or receive the COVID-19 vaccine
  - Netflix scams – phishing email promising a free year of Netflix
  - CALL – Community Assistance Liaison program is now in effect, mental health professionals responding to non-violent calls with officers
  - All officers now have body cams
