# Techniques Used by Scam Artists





- IMPOSTERS pretend to be Government Agents (IRS, S.S.A., P.C. Jail)
- MANIPULATE Feelings & Emotions
- FORCE you make a Fast Decision/Threaten you
- DISGUISE their Phone Numbers, using Fake Caller ID's (Spoofing)
- ATTEMPT to obtain your Personal Information
- OFFER "Too Good to be True Opportunities"
- CONVINCE people to do things which are NOT LOGICAL (Pay in Gift Cards, Wire Transfers, Pay Taxes or Upfront Loan Payments)

### How to Protect Yourself from SCAMS



- UNDERSTAND Government (IRS, SSA) will NEVER:
  - 1. Call you, they Communicate via Certified Letter
  - 2. Never Threaten to ARREST you
  - 3. Force You to Pay Immediately while on the Phone.
  - 4. Request Payment in GIFT CARDS / WIRE TRANSFERS
- VERIFICATION Call the Agency Directly
- SPEAK with a Trusted Advisor BEFORE making Financial Decisions
- PROTECT Personal and Financial Information
- NEVER give someone REMOTE ACCESS to your computer
- DON'T BE AFRAID to Hang Up on Unsolicited Phone Calls
